

As the most important tourist city in Wallonia, Liege has innumerable riches in store waiting to be discovered. The characteristic districts, the river Meuse, which transects from South to North, the abrupt and wooded hills surrounding it as well as its marked relief, providing a multitude of original perspectives give the city an exceptional charm. A vigorous cultural and artistic life and a considerable architectural heritage combine to make this an essential part of any trip to Belgium.



THE MUST-SEES

THE HISTORICAL HEART

Set out on a discovery of the historical Hors-Château – Féronstrée area, which boasts a series of old buildings and prestigious museums. The commercial area takes on a lively and international flavour with its La Batte market on Sundays and its antique quarter. **Must-sees**: the Place Saint-Lambert, the Palace of the Prince-Bishops, the Place du Marché, the Perron monument and the town hall, the Saint-Antoine courtyard, the side streets and more...

GRAND CURTIUS MUSEUM

Major art and history museum complex, bringing together collections of weaponry, glass, archaeology, decorative art, religious and Mosan art. www.grandcurtiusliege.be



ARCHEOFORUM

The basement of the square contains the vestiges still in place of the oldest occupations of the city: prehistoric traces, walls of a Gallo-Roman villa, remains of medieval buildings including vestiges of the Romanesque and Gothic cathedrals www.archeoforumdeliege.be



BAPTISMAL FONT OF THE SAINT-BARTHELEMY CHURCH

Masterpiece of goldsmithing of the early 12th century. By the high quality of its reliefs and its execution, it is considered to be one of the seven artistic wonders of Belgium. www.st-barthelemy.be

THE HILLSIDE OF THE CITADEL NATURE AT THE HEART OF THE CITY

The hillside of the citadel is a popular spot classed 3 stars in the famous Michelin Green Guide. Having wandered through streets bathed in history, you will find yourself trule behind the city scenes, traversing a labyrinth of courtyards, steps, alleys, gardens and meadows.



LA BATTE

Large market (2 km) on Sunday mornings held on the banks of the river Meuse. It is one of the oldest and largest in Belgium.

Every Sunday 8 am - 2 pm



THE CATHEDRAL DISTRICT

The city centre is the true heartbeat of Liege. Shopping addicts and food-lovers will be in their element. An ideal place for pedestrians to take a stroll.



SAINT-PAUL CATHEDRAL AND TREASURY

Integrated in the cloistered annexes, this museum presents an exceptional course through the art and history of the ancient principality of Liege. – www.tresordeliege.be



CHURCH SAINT-JACQUES

This Gothic-style building was thoroughly renovated from 1514 to 1538 and only the Romanesque building (12th century) was preserved. In 1558 a porch was added in Renaissance style. One of the most beautiful churches in Belgium.

CITÉ MIROIR

The former Sauvenière Baths become La Cité Miroir. An exceptional place dedicated to education and culture. Live events, performances, debates, exhibitions, conferences, educational courses.

THE GUILLEMINS RAILWAY STATION

This work of the great Spanish architect Santiago Calatrava was open in 2009. Strong architectural symbol, it is one of the most beautiful railway stations in Europe..



OUTREMEUSE ISLAND

Just cross the river Meuse and you're in Outremeuse district (beyond the Meuse river). This is the true land of folklore so beautifully described by Georges Simenon. This is a neighbourhood typical of Liege with its winding alleys decorated with potales (little chapels dedicated to the Virgin Mary).





LA BOVERIE - FINE ARTS & EXHIBITIONS

The park of la Boverie, located between the Meuse and the «Dérivation» canal, is a place for family leisure, open to all and open to the world. The rose garden, the Nicolas Schöffer Tower, a new footbridge, make it a lovely place for leisure. The building which was constructed in the framework of the 1905 World Expo has become "La Boverie", the cultural masterpiece of the park www.laboverie.com



AQUARIUM - MUSÉUM

Approximately 200 species of ocean, sea, lake and river fishes from around the world populate the 50 pools of the Aquarium and stuffed animals from every continent are exhibited at the muséum. – www.aquarium-museum.be
